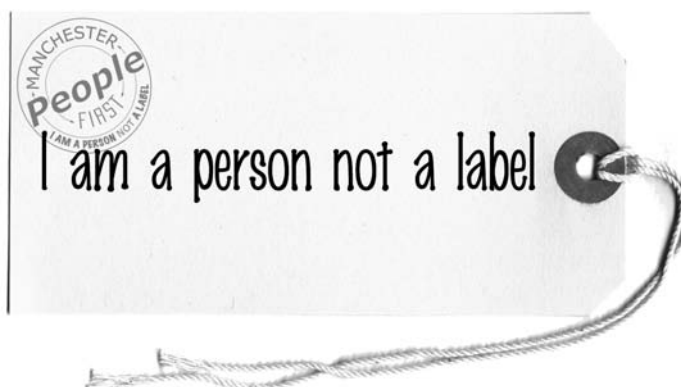

The work is paid and will last for 12 months, but we may get funding to carry on longer.

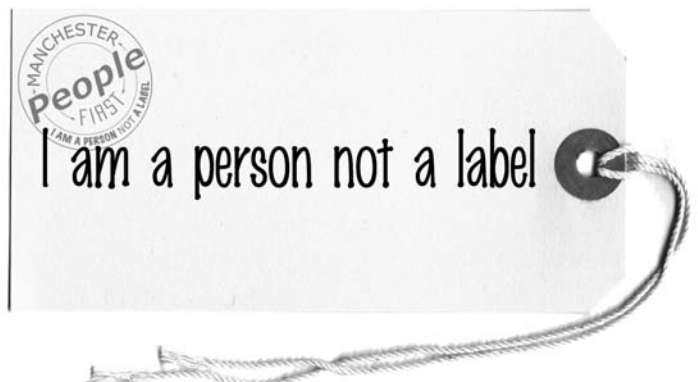
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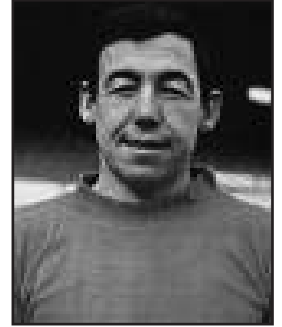

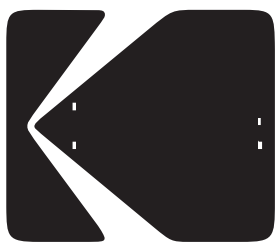
